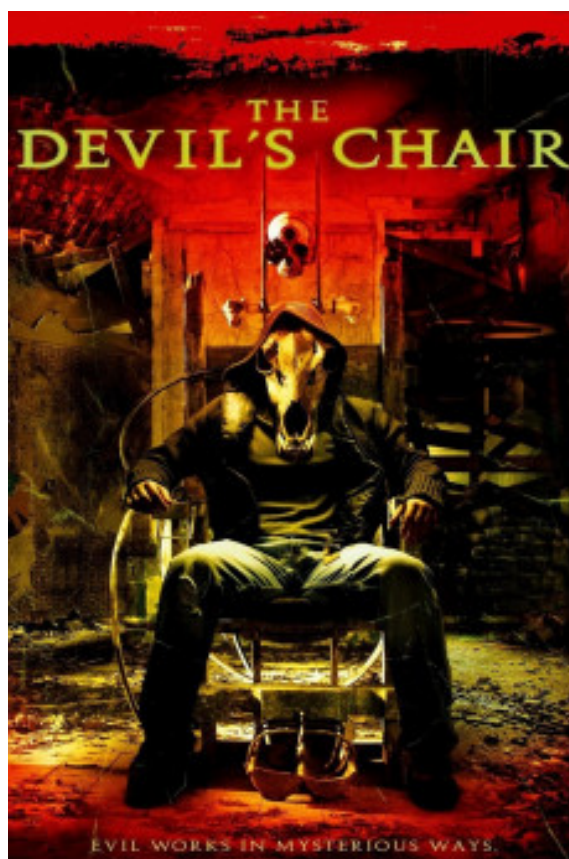

None of the reviews are written by the customers who are purchasing the this product. **PRODUCT DETAILS.** Non-Stop was released in the cinema in 2014 as a very close copy of The Bourne Trilogy. **Q:** How do you make an image bigger while preserving the aspect ratio of the browser window? As a part of a job interview, I have to fill an HTML form, which includes a rather large image, which I need to fit on the entire form. I have tried setting the height and width of the image to 100% and this makes the image size exactly as needed to fill the form. However, in order to fit in the width of the browser window, I need to increase the width of the image, which then creates a problem: When the browser window is resized, I need the image to scale proportionally (which, in my case, is the height of the image to the width). I have tried setting the width and height to percentages and this works for the size of the window, but when I resize the window the image gets smaller, but then if I resize it again the browser becomes smaller, and the image gets larger again. What's

the solution? Thanks! A: You can also add a class to your image and set your width and height to percentages based on the image's original width and height: `.image-container { width: 100%; height: 100%; overflow: hidden; } .image-container img {`
Here's a working fiddle: You could put your inside a relatively positioned div and give that div `width:100%` and `height:auto`.
